Curved silver tubes and semi-precious focal beads unite in this stylish design from Kalash Beads.



To make bracelet:

Materials

All available from www.kalash.com.au

- 2 Thai Hill Tribe silver curved tube beads
- 25cm 0.38mm tiger tail
- 5cm French wire (tigertail covering)

- 2 2.8mm round ball crimp beads (A9b) OR 4 small ring crimps (A9i) — 2 each end
- Centre feature bead of your choice
- 10 to 12 mixed silver or semi-precious beads to flank main bead (number of beads will be dependant on wrist size)
- 1 clasp — fob style, 'S' hook style or parrot clasp
- Extension chain (optional)

Tools

- Round-nose pliers
- Flat-nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Beading tray (optional)



THIS IS A SIMPLE but very stylish design from Kalash Beads — the sort of bracelet that stands out for all the right reasons: a strong bead, beautiful curved silver accent tubes and complementary secondary beads.

Step 1:

Cut tiger tail to fit your wrist (average wrist size is 18cm).

Step 2:

Feed the crimp/s and French wire onto one end of your tiger tail, thread on the clasp and loop back through your crimp bead/s. To secure, squeeze the crimp using flat-nose pliers.

Step 3:

Lay out your beads on a beading tray in the plan of your bracelet, ensuring your feature bead is centred.

Step 4:

Thread on your selected end beads, Hill Tribe silver curved tube, centre feature bead, Hill Tribe silver curved tube and final end beads.

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
