

MATERIALS

36cm Chain
7 x Thai silver charms
10 x head pins
16 x small clasps
1 x clasp

BEADS

7-12 tumbled or faceted beads

TOOLS

Chain nose pliers
Round nose pliers
Cutters

LENGTH: 19cm

The amazing feature of this bracelet is that you can rearrange, add or remove charms at any time.
Designed by Kalash.

STEP ONE

Cut chain into 2 x 18cm lengths.

STEP TWO

Using pliers open the jump ring of clasp, attach through both chain ends, on one side of chains.

STEP THREE

Lay out charms and beads out in the desired order to attach them onto the chain.

STEP FOUR

Thread each of the beads onto 1 x head pin. Form a wrapped loop using round

nose pliers, add each head pin to one small removable clasp before completing wrap. See basic instructions for easy steps in forming wrapped loops. Trim the excess wire. Repeat for all stone beads.

STEP FIVE

Attach each of the silver charms to a small removable clasp by opening each jump ring on charm using two pliers; grasp the jump ring each side, turn it sideways to

open the ring, slide a silver charm on and reverse the turn to close the jump ring. Repeat for all silver charms.

STEP SIX

Once all items are attached to a removable clasp, start attaching them in your desired order, onto the chain. Measure wrist length and when attaching last charm on each side, leave at least five rings on the chain to attach your large clasp to. As you attach the charms, either loop them onto both strands or keep them attached to the single chain.
