

# Garnets and pearls

Go a little boho with these stylish earrings from Kalash Beads

## To make earrings:

### Materials

Customer codes shown for ordering:

- \* 14 50mm earring pins (code A12 c.1)
- \* 34 pearl rice beads (#993)
- \* 40 4mm garnet button beads (#3071)
- \* 1 pair filigree round earring drops (A26e)
- \* 1 pair earring hooks (A11i)

### Tools

- \* Flat-nose pliers
- \* Round-nose pliers
- \* Wire cutters

## Step 1

### OUTER DANGLES:

Onto four earring pins thread one garnet bead, one rice pearl, one garnet pearl and one rice pearl. Trim your earring pins to approximately 7mm from last bead and create a loop by turning wire at a right angle with flat-nose pliers and then rolling into a loop with round-nose pliers.

rice pearl. Trim wire and create loops for each, as above.

## Step 3

### CENTRE DANGLE:

Onto one earring pin thread one garnet bead, one rice pearl, one garnet bead, one rice pearl and one garnet bead. Trim wire and create a loop.

## Step 2

### INNER DANGLES:

Onto two earring pins thread one garnet bead, one rice pearl, one garnet bead, one rice pearl, one garnet bead and one

## Step 4

Open each dangle loop and thread onto one filigree earring drop. Attach centre dangle onto the filigree earring drop's centre loop, then

your inner dangles, so they flank this centre drop. Last, add your four outer dangles to the two outside earring drop loops on either side of your inner dangles.

## Step 5

Use pliers to open earring hook, thread onto filigree earring drop top loop and close.
